



## FINANCIAL ELIGIBILITY

*An applicant from a household with total incomes at or below the following levels is financially eligible to apply for a CEF tuition award.*

**Definition of a Household:** Household size means a group of related or non-related individuals who are living as one economic unit and are sharing living expenses. Living expenses include rent, clothes, food, doctor bills, utilities (electrical, gas, water) and the like.

**Definition of a one-member household:** A household of one means a pupil who is his/her sole support. Institutionalized children are always one-member households. Foster children are one-member households only if the welfare/placement agency maintains legal responsibility for the child.

*The annual gross income amounts indicated below are the family income guidelines for all CEF Tuition Award Programs.*
